

Corona: We protect your child, you and us



Ward visitors regulation

One accompanying person per patient can be present in the children's hospital around the clock. A second person may visit between 10 am and 8 pm.

In addition to the permanent accompanying person, two different visitors may be received per day.



Stay at home when you have symptoms

Persons with a cold, cough, fever or COVID-19 (up to 7 days after positive test result) are not allowed to visit.



Keep your distance

Keep a distance of 1.5m from other patients, their accompanying persons and the staff in the patient room.



You must wear a mask

Masks must be worn by all persons over the age of 6 in the entire hospital.

Exceptions:

- The patient may take off the mask in the patient room when in bed, if no member of staff is nearby (<1.5m).
- The accompanying person may only take off the mask in the patient room during the day for eating or drinking and at night for sleeping.



Hand hygiene

Wash your hands with water and soap or disinfect them when entering the patient room and after you have put on or taken off the hygiene mask.
